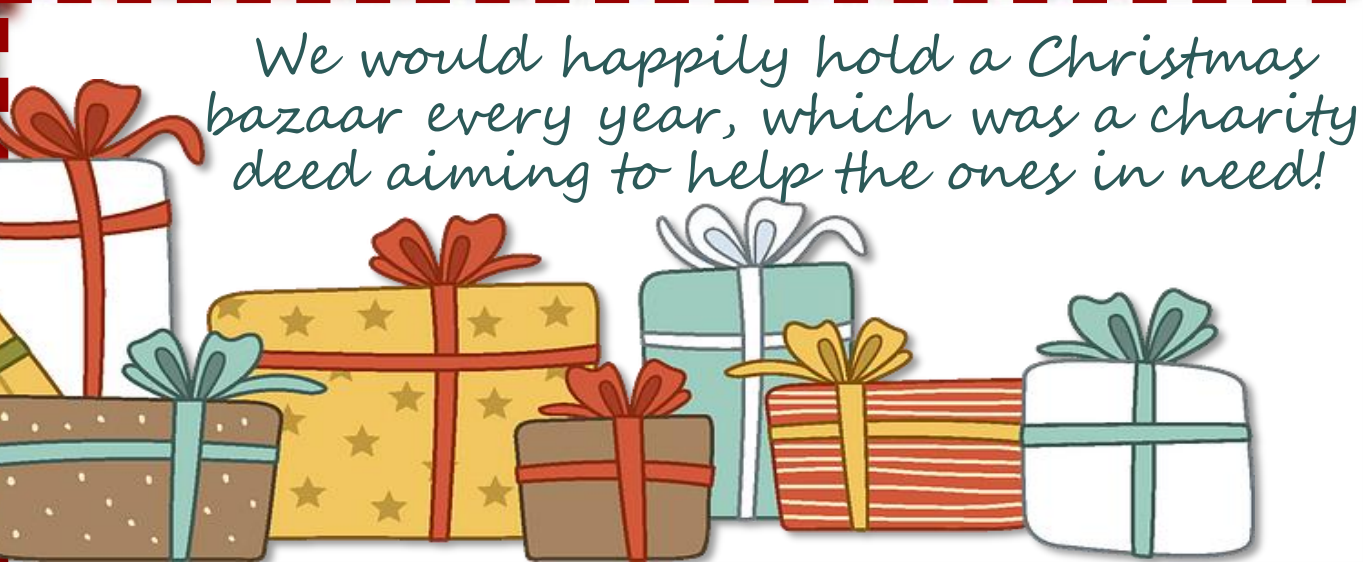






Performing
